- 1. Any message containing profanity, obscenity, offensive remarks, etc. will not be approved.
- 2. When a moderator deems a message to be personal or confidential or not addressed to the community, the message will not be approved.
- 3. Emails on the same topic, six or more, will be considered a discussion and will be redirected to a discussion forum(*) or to offline discussions among the senders. The moderator will follow an exception to this policy when a moderator deems a matter an emergency(**) or a special circumstance(***).
- 4. When a moderator deems a message conflicts with BAGA's interest, the moderator will direct the message to a discussion forum at the Board's discretion. An entity can conflict BAGA's interest when it conflicts with the goals of BAGA as defined in by-laws or attempts to misrepresent or harm BAGA or its member(s).
- 5. Up to two announcements for an event organized by an organization other than BAGA will be approved, at the Board's discretion.
- 6. Messages containing suspicious attachments or URLs will not be approved. Messages with unverified (****) links will not be approved.
- 7. BAGA reserves the right to deny any email or change membership and subscription. Any subscriber found to send virus or spam will be removed without notice.
- 8. Any change in the moderation policies has to be approved by 2/3rd majority of the BAGA BODs. Change in policy will be emailed to members as an amendment to current policy.
- *Discussion forum is subject to technology availability by provider
- **Example of emergencies are (but not limited to): serious illness or death in community,
- ***Example of special circumstances are (but not limited to): a celebratory event in BD or US
- **** If time permits moderator may verify the link and approve the message
